**Health**: Health is a state of complete physical, mental and social well-being and not merely the absence of disease or infirmity (WHO<sup>1</sup>)

**Safety:** Freedom from unacceptable risks of harm (ISO/IEC Guide 2<sup>2</sup>)

**Sustainable Work Environments (within the H&M Group):** The design, conditions and actions within the workplace that aims to promote employees wellbeing with a long term perspective

**Health and Safety Culture (within the H&M Group)**: The values, attitudes and knowledge that contributes to proactive decisions and behaviours regarding Health and Safety within all operations
