WBC members often share insights that help our business and plan events and activities throughout the year to get the team involved in the community.



### Good to know

Target strives for equity for its women team members and celebrates their achievements and contributions to Target's success:

- 58% of Target team members are women and 50% of Target's leadership team is women.
- Half of Target's stores are run by women.
- We pay all team members equitably, regardless of gender, race or ethnicity.
- One third of our Board of Directors are women.
- In 2019-2021 we:
  - Increased female representation in Target India by 24%.
  - Steadily increased promotions of women to senior leadership positions by 16%.
  - Doubled the promotional rate of women of color to senior leadership.
