Chevron is confident that the [EITI's multi-stakeholder](#) approach, which ensures the full representation of governments, extractive industry companies and civil society, is the best approach for providing transparency in company payments and government revenues in resource-rich countries.

The company has been a member of the multi-stakeholder groups (MSG) in several countries implementing the [EITI Standard](#) such as **Azerbaijan, Philippines, Republic of Congo** and United States during its years of implementation of the EITI Standard.

Chevron is one of the longest continuous serving members of the international [EITI Board](#) and is currently a member of the EITI Board 2019-2021.
